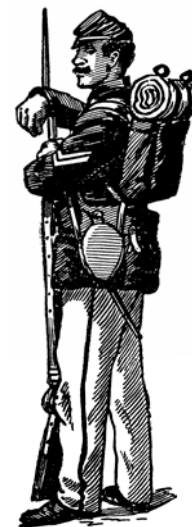


The N-SSA's 11th NJ Volunteer Infantry and

† — Smoothbore team matches will be held if there are at least four teams participating. Smoothbore teams must supply their own timer and safety.

‡ — BB gun matches are limited to competitors between 4 and 14 years of age and must be sponsored by a current member of the N-SSA. All competitors must be directly supervised by an adult at all times. Both competitors and their sponsors must bring their own eye protection. All N-SSA BB gun match rules and safety regulations will apply.

Carbine (5 competitors per team)
20 backed clay pigeons @ 50 yards
10 hanging 4" tiles @ 50 yards
10 hanging mini pigeons @ 50 yards
10 hanging clay pigeons @ 50 yards
8 hanging 6" tiles @ 100 yards

Smoothbore (3 competitors per team)
9 backed clay pigeons @ 25 yards
6 hanging 4" tiles @ 25 yards
6 hanging mini pigeons @ 25 yards
6 hanging clay pigeons @ 25 yards
6 hanging 6" tiles @ 50 yards

Musket (8 competitors per team)
32 backed clay pigeons @ 50 yards
16 hanging 4" tiles @ 50 yards
16 hanging mini pigeons @ 50 yards
16 hanging clay pigeons @ 50 yards
10 hanging 6" tiles @ 100 yards

Team medals awarded for:

Musket teams — Classes A1, A2, A3 & B1 — 1st & 2nd places in each class
Carbine teams — Classes A1, A2, A3 & B1 — 1st & 2nd places in each class
Smoothbore teams — Unclassified — 1st & 2nd places overall only

Individual events (uniforms optional):

50 & 100 yard musket
50 & 100 yard carbine
50 & 100 yard breechloader
25 & 50 yard smoothbore
25 & 50 yard revolver

Individual events are \$1.50 for the first target per event and \$1.00 for each re-entry.
Protests will be accepted at \$1.00 for each protest.
